Scholarships 2015-16

Academic Excellence Scholarship \$10,000 - \$20,000

- Applicants must have scored a minimum of 85% or equivalent in their previous degree/award/high school equivalent
- An award of \$10,000 or \$20,000 will be paid across semesters
- Must be commencing international students wanting to undertake undergraduate or postgraduate coursework full degrees at La Trobe University in 2015 or 2016
- Applicants must meet university academic and English language entry requirements at the commencement date of their course
- Applicants must have received a letter of offer at the time of applying for this scholarship
- Preference given to students whose course is 2 years or over

Application closing dates:

- **Semester 2, 2015:** 8 May 2015
- **Semester 1, 2016:** 11 September, 13 November, 8 January 2016

Regional Campus Scholarship \$5,000

- Students must study an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at one of our regional campuses in Bendigo, Shepparton, Albury-Wodonga or Mildura.
- Not receiving any other scholarship or sponsorship

ELICOS Scholarship 5-10 Weeks


- 5 or 10 weeks of English language tuition may be offered to privately funded students (not sponsored) who package ELICOS with a La Trobe degree

La Trobe International Student Scholarship

- Must be commencing international student wanting to undertake undergraduate or postgraduate coursework full degrees at La Trobe University in 2015 or 2016
- Amount up to \$9,500 for tuition fees

La Trobe Business School Scholarships

- Must be commencing international student wanting to undertake Masters level program in the La Trobe Business School
- Applicants must have a GPA of 70% or above
- Scholarships are available for MBA programs (\$10,000), Master of Management (\$5,000), Master by Coursework (\$5,000) and are only available for Semester 2 2015 at this stage

Research

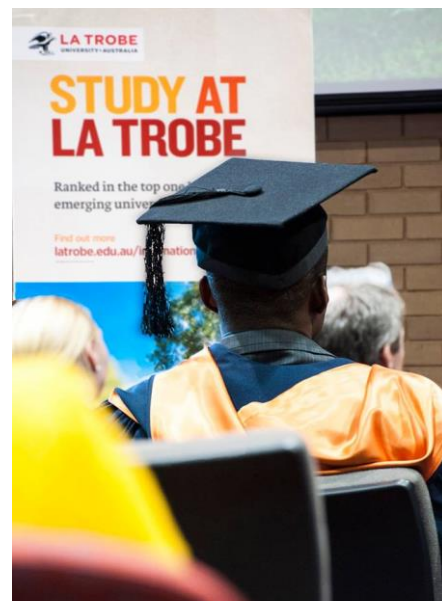
